God uses each and every one of us, ordinary people, to accomplish His mission of reaching every man, woman and child with the GOOD NEWS of Jesus!



Verse 3 talks about being like a tree planted beside flowing streams. What do you think this means?









"But I trust in your unfailing love. I will rejoice because you have rescued me. I will sing to the Lord because He is good to me." PSALM 13: 5-6







In this Chapter, David writes out a song. Try writing a few lines of a song sharing your heart with God.







READ PSALM 63:1-8




In these verses, David shares how he wants to be close to God, so so very much. What are things you can do to be close to God?



These verses begin by saying, "Let all that I am praise the Lord; with my whole heart, I will praise His holy name." When we read that verse, it sounds beautiful and something we would easily agree that we want to do! But when it says let ALL that I am praise the Lord, it means the good parts of us AND the bad parts of us too.

This line is actually repeated more than once, which means it must be something really important, and good for us to pay special attention to! "All that I am" includes the things we are really good at and the things we are not. It includes the things about us that are "good" or pleasing to God, and the things we do that make Him sad.


This means that we can praise God, when we feel like we are doing good things that God likes, and when we make mistakes and sin. Praising Him with ALL that we have opens up the opportunity for us to always be praising God. Journal below about how we can always be praising God, in our good and bad moments.







These verses have a lot of beautiful descriptions! As you read, it's easy to visualize the many things that David is talking about. Draw some of these images out to help you remember today's scriptures.




