



As we prepare to return to Topsail High School for worship on July 12th, the following are the steps we have taken to ensure the health of our attendees. Our team has reviewed and updated all of our policies and procedures as they pertain to cleanliness and safety. While we cant wait to return to a physical gathering, we will maintain our commitment to offering a great online experience through our online community for those who are unable to attend.

The following outlines what you can expect to experience when you return.

**SERVICES //** We will reopen with our regular service times; 9:15 am & 11:15 am at Topsail High School and live stream our services to our online community via our website, Facebook, and Youtube.

## **PREPARING FOR REOPENING //**

- All portable equipment that attendees will come in contact with has been sanitized prior to reopening. All kids ministry carpets and flooring has been shampooed and sanitized to the best of our ability. All kids ministry play panels, toys and usable equipment has been sanitized and cleaned prior to reopening. Additionally, any hard services have been cleaned and sanitized prior to reopening.
- Renovation continues to partner with the custodial team at Topsail High School to ensure the facility has been throughly cleaned prior to reopening.

## **CLEANNES AND SAFETY PROCEDURES //**

### **Kids Environments:**

- All doors will be held for families who enter and exit.
- Volunteers have been trained on updated sanitation guidelines.
- Per our policies, all equipment and environments will be cleaned and sanitized pre and post service. This includes toys, chairs, play panels, hard surfaces etc.
- Check-in stations will be spaced out as much as possible.
- Volunteers will be available at check-in stations to assist families with check in process.
- Sanitation stations will be available at each point of entry. Kids will be asked to sanitize hands upon entry to ministry space.
- We will ask attendees to self-screen before attending a service. Anyone experiencing fever, cough, or other COVID-19 symptoms should not attend.
- Temperature checks will be administered to all children by RENO-KIDS volunteers via Non-Contact Infrared Digital Thermometer's.
- Any child that is showing sign of general non-well being have their temperature check with no touch thermometers and the parent will be contacted. If a child is sick, the

parent will be contacted immediately and they will be removed from their environment while waiting for the parent to arrive.

- We continue to encourage single parent drop off / pick up to limit contact.
- Toys that are unused or unnecessary have been removed to promote healthy environments.

### **Worship Services:**

- All doors will be held open for those who enter and exit.
- Host teams will refrain from handshakes and high-fives.
- All hard services will be disinfected prior, in-between and following each service.
- Sanitation stations will be available at each point of entry.
- Seating will be disinfected pre and post service.
- Seating will be adjusted to provide adequate room for families/individuals to practice social distancing.
- Offering boxes will be available at each entry/exit location as we will not be passing offering baskets.
- For those who are unable to attend, we will continue to offer our online community (9:15 & 11:15).
- Worship guides will not be placed on chairs when we reopen but will be available at the entry points if you would like to take one.
- Based on the Governor's face mask order (June 26), attendees are encouraged to wear a face mask for their safety and the safety of others.
- For the foreseeable future we will not be doing community time.
- When leadership determines an appropriate time to take the Lord's Supper, prepackaged juice and wafer containers will be used.
- For the summer months, Renovation will only be hosting one beach baptism celebration.

### **Guest Experience:**

- All doors will be held open for those who enter and exit.
- Guest services volunteers will wear face masks.
- Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized, pre, during and post services.
- Attendees are welcome to wear a face mask for their safety and comfort.
- Coffee and water will not be available.
- Host teams will refrain from handshakes and high-fives.
- Sanitation stations will be available at each point of entry.

- Worship guides will not be placed on chairs when we reopen but will be available at the entry points if you would like to take one.
- Prayer team remains a priority at the conclusion of each service but strives to stand at a 3ft distance to minimize contact.
